

Salem Health Hospitals & Clinics – Provider Groups and Facilities Tier List

All medical plans cover the same types of medical services but at different benefit levels based on the network tier of your provider. Your provider's tier impacts how much you pay toward your:

- Deductible (the amount you pay for covered health care before your plan starts to pay)
- Cost-sharing (the amount you pay for covered health care after you meet your deductible)
- Out-of-pocket maximum (the annual limit before your plan covers 100% of costs)

This document lists the provider groups and facilities within each tiered network.

Tier I

The Tier I medical network will cover services at the highest benefit level. It is limited to providers of the following:

- Salem Health Hospitals & Clinics and facilities
- West Valley Hospital

Not all services have a Tier I provider.

Tier II

The Tier II network utilizes Moda's Connexus network and includes providers and clinics that generally provide services that are not available at Salem Health Hospitals & Clinics. This includes, but is not limited to:
